Last week, Rob Ludwig caught a tagged walleye and wondered who to report it to and what it was all about.

Arunas Liskauskas from the MNR responded to Sandy Boeckh's inquiry this way: "We were tagging spawning walleye at

the Shawanaga River rapids, tagging muskellunge as part of a collaborative study with McMaster University and tagging both Walleye and Muskellunge during our broad fish community survey that just finished last week..

These efforts are part of a new strategic assessment program that we have embarked on that includes a more focused effort aimed at understanding the dynamics of our walleye populations. These efforts are also in support of our recent initiation of the development of a Walleye management plan for the Ontario waters of Lake Huron."
