Do you know CPR (perhaps take the course offered below in this eBlast)

Do you know what to do in the case of excessive bleeding?

Non-Medical Emergencies:

Please remember that PaBIA's Marine Patrollers, Nate and Alex, are first responders and available to assist 8:30 - 5:00 pm every day except Wednesdays.

Call: 705-773-9283. Copy down and put this number by your phone...or better yet, add them to your contacts in your cellphones.

Fire Emergencies:

PaBERT's fireboat will NOT be in operation this summer

Know where the PaBIA firepumps are by checking the PaBIA maps NOW

Be aware of where there are fire pumps in your neighborhood by checking the Fire Pump Listings on pages 140-143 of this year's Yearbook

PaBIA strongly suggests a *neighborhood watch program* such that you contact your neighbors on the Bay **NOW** to discuss how you might help each other in case of an emergency.

Keep this plan in a central place in your cottage including necessary phone numbers so they are accessible in an emergency.
