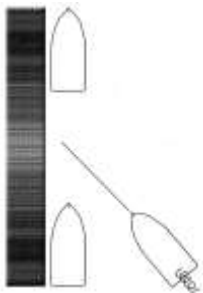
Nate Stapulionis and Max Ullrich

We plan to race on Saturday July 11th at 2 pm. The race course will comprise a triangle with marks at the east end of Ojibway Bay, near 324A and near Pushwah Island (172A). The starting point is wind dependent but prevailing winds would suggest an Ojibway Bay start.

The Rendezvous for the sailors is at the Tremayne cottage (313A). Docking is extremely limited so bring your smaller boats.

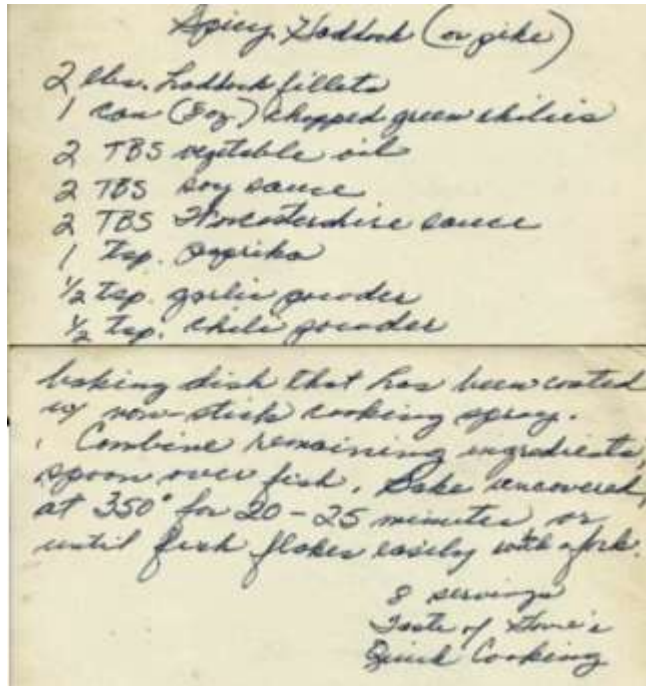
