CPR Course - August 11th 9:00 a.m. - Noon

With PaBERT not running this summer, we again ask the question: Would you know how to administer life saving CPR? It's one thing to be in the city where an ambulance is just a call away. But it is quite another to be on an island 20 minutes from the mainland with no help on the way. Either way, taking a few hours to learn how to do CPR could save the life of someone close to you. So PaBIA wants to encourage you to take a CPR course this summer and has solicited St. John Ambulance to offer a CPR level "A" courses, as well as an AED course.

Black Spots On Fish - What Are They and



Are They Harmful to You or the Fish?

Black spot is one of the most frequently observed parasites on fish, appearing as small black spots or cysts in the fish's skin, fins and flesh.

In the black spot life cycle, fish-eating birds such as herons and kingfishers eat an infected fish. The larval stage, which is inside the black cyst, develops into an adult in the bird. Eggs are laid by the adult and pass into the water where they hatch and infect snails. Eventually

they leave the snail host and burrow through the skin of fish and form cysts, which the fish surrounds with a black pigment.

This organism does little harm to the fish, but gives the fish an unsightly appearance. Infected fish can be consumed with proper cooking.
