Fishing Committee Job Description & Duties

The Fishing Committee's main mission is to promote the sport of fishing in the area and help educate everyone on how to preserve this natural resource for enjoyment of generations to come.

The main tools and responsibilities to accomplish this are:

- 1. Develop and submit an annual report by the end of January giving updates on any major changes in environment & government laws and regulations including how to obtain a license and current costs.
- 2. Develop a series of short e-blast articles (12-15) that run during the summer that support our mission. Currently we attempt to have 50% of the articles about consumption, evasive species updates and technical updates on fishing techniques. The other 50% we attempt to share family fishing stories from the summer to help promote the sport in the area and to gain advocates for environmentally correct efforts to preserve our resource.
- 3. Develop and write two Newsletter articles for the Fall and Spring promoting our Mission.

The Fishing Committee reports to the Environmental Chairperson Head.
